The organisers would like to thank all the local communities, residents and businesses along the route for their support and patience.

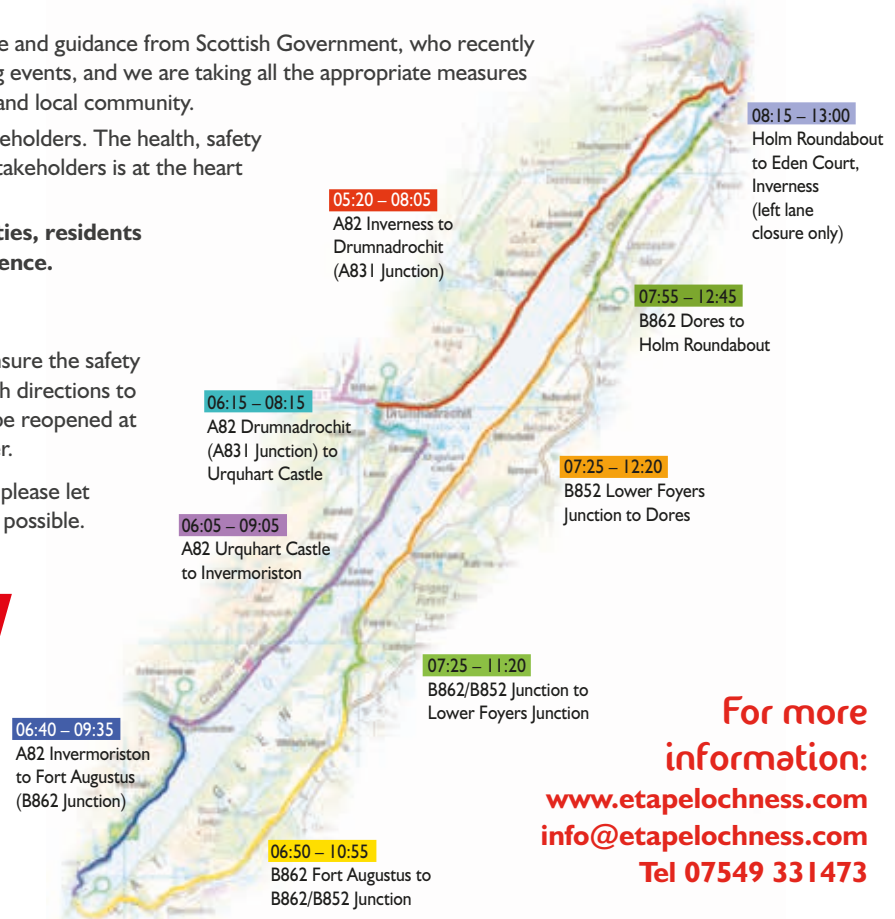
Temporary Traffic Restrictions
