


# ETAPE LOCH NESS

The Etape Loch Ness is a closed road cycle sportive following a 66-mile route around iconic Loch Ness, starting and finishing in Inverness.


Thousands of pounds will be raised by cyclists for our official charity Macmillan Cancer Support.

We have kept traffic restrictions to a minimum to ensure the safety of participants and other road users. Roads will be closed in both directions to create a safe traffic-free environment for the event. Roads will be reopened at these times or as soon as it is safe to do so, which may be earlier.
